

REX RABBIT AUCTIONS

The National Rex Club annually sponsors 50-50 Rex Rabbit Auctions at both the National Rex Show in the spring and the A.R.B.A. Convention in the fall. The purpose of this event is two-fold in that it acts as a fund-raiser for the National Rex Club and aids in the wider distribution of quality Rex to enhance and strengthen the Rex Breed.

All Rex Club members, including Youth members are eligible to consign quality Rex at all Auctions.

An appointed Review Committee consisting of qualified Club members and/or A.R.B.A. Judges will examine and evaluate all potential consignments to insure that only healthy, quality Rex are accepted for Auctions.

Consignments are sold by public Auction to the highest bidder with the consigner receiving one half of selling price and the National Rex Club receiving one half.

Revenue received by the National Rex Club at the National Rex Show Auction is assigned to our Rex Guidebook Fund to assist in funding the cost of publishing a new Rex Guidebook every five years. Revenue received at the A.R.B.A. Convention Auction is assigned to our Youth Scholarship Fund.

The President will appoint a Chairperson for each Auction who will manage and conduct the Auction under the Guidelines set forth by the Rex Club.

The National Rex Club as the Auction sponsor serves only as a medium between consigner and buyer and will not be held responsible to resolve any disputes that may arise.

The National Rex Club will assure that all consigners will receive their appropriate payments from all consignments sold.
